Our next workshop is going to be held in Valencia, Spain. The workshop is now in its preparation steps.

It will take place in Hotel Rey don Jaime (http://www.hotelreydonjaimevalencia.com/)

We will begin on the morning of Wednesday, October 5th and finish in the afternoon of Thursday October 6th, 2016. Amalia Muñoz and Peter Wiesen are the local and international organizers.

The aim of the workshop is to present and discuss among selected international researchers the current knowledge on air quality with a focus on new results in atmospheric chemistry, the impacts of gaseous and particulate organic compounds on air quality and climate change. Reliable emission inventories and modelling for predicting future atmospheric composition are also topics of the workshop.

The workshop will follow the format of a series of short lectures with ample time for discussions organized under the following topics:

- Emissions from traffic, solvent use, and natural sources. Evaluation of Emissions inventories
- Transformation of air pollutants: atmospheric simulation chamber studies, and laboratory experiments
- Transformation of air pollutants: Field Studies
- Chemical/Transport modelling of primary and secondary pollutants in urban and regional areas
